Waste	Handling
Solid waste: Gloves, tissues, paper, syringes, etc.	Dispose of the waste as ordinary waste.
Sharp waste: Glass, broken glass, hypodermic needles, sharp objects	Put in the yellow bins. When the container is full, contact lab. responsible (or HSTs handyman*) for proper disposal through BioMedicine group.
Blood sampling tubes	Put in the container marked "BLOOD" When the container is full, contact lab. responsible (or HSTs handyman*) for proper disposal through BioMedicine group.
Liquids without biologically active material	May be poured directly into the sink.
Chemical and solvents without biologically active material	If vial/container contains chemical or solvent then put it in the container marked "VIALS + CHEMICALS". If it is empty put it in the container marked "EMPTY VIALS". When the container is full, contact lab. responsible (or HSTs handyman*) for proper disposal through BioMedicine group.
Batteries Large waste, etc.	Hand in batteries at "Komponenten", Fr.B.7 room B1-104 For further assistance and information contact HSTs handyman*.

NOTE: All vials, containers, medicines kept in the lab or fridge must be labeled with the content, name of the investigator and expiration date. Please leave a contact number or e-mail for further information if it is required.
