Chemical Workplace Assessment

Students and employees have to fill in a Chemical Workplace Assessment form, if they are working with chemicals that are carcinogens, reproduction damaging or mutagenic. It has to be made for the specific chemical and the specific experiment

For example; if you make a 4 % paraformaldehyde, and it is going to be used for perfusion, you have to make a Chemical workplace assessment form for both the solutions and the experiments.

The students may not have access to this folder, so the supervisor is responsible to send them a Chemical workplace assessment form by email. The students need guidance from a supervisor to fill in this form, and sign it afterwards.

When it's done place it in the folder (Chemical Workplace Assessment) in the chemical cupboard in room 1.231A.
